It was reported that State Rep. Karen Whitsett of Detroit has credited the anti-malarial drug hydroxychloroquine with saving her life after she tested positive for COVID-19.

From the Desk of Florida Attorney General Ashley Moody

Track Stimulus Payment to Prevent Fraud

TALLAHASSEE, Fla.—Attorney General Ashley Moody today issued a Consumer Alert urging Floridians who have not already received a stimulus payment from the federal government to take steps to avoid benefits-related scams. According to the Internal Revenue Service, millions of Americans have already received stimulus payments and millions more are still waiting on the emergency benefits. The IRS created a payment tracking tool for those still waiting.

Attorney General Ashley Moody said, "This new tool can help Floridians avoid stimulus-related fraud. By working directly with the IRS to track your payment—the likelihood of being duped by scammers sending fake messages designed to steal payments or personal information is greatly reduced. I want to encourage all Floridians to stay up-to-date on COVID-19 news and government actions associated with the pandemic, so they are better prepared to spot and report scams."

The new payment tracking tool can be accessed at [IRS.gov](https://www.irs.gov). On the website, users can also access the IRS tool designed to allow beneficiaries to request an earlier stimulus payment. Payments are being made via direct deposit and checks in the mail. While we understand the website experienced some early glitches, it appears to now be operating. If you have issues accessing the site, contact the IRS at 1(800) 829-1040.

Even before the U.S. Congress passed the COVID-19 stimulus package, scammers were already sending fake message designed to exploit the payments to steal people's personal and financial information. By working with the IRS directly, Floridians should be better

From Desk of Governor Ron DeSantis

More Than 32,000 Laptops Going to Small and Rural School Districts

On April 11, 2020, in News Releases, by Staff

Tallahassee, Fla. – Today, Governor Ron DeSantis and Education Commissioner Richard Corcoran announced that 32,614 laptop computers are being distributed to 34 mostly small, rural school districts throughout Florida and the Florida A&M University Developmental Research School. This was made possible through a partnership with the Panhandle Area Educational Consortium (PAEC), Northeast Florida Educational Consortium (NEFEC) and Heartland Educational Consortium (HEC), and three additional school districts that are not members of a consortium.

“Today's announcement speaks volumes about how the Department of Education, our school districts and our teachers are coming together to ensure Florida students have the resources they need to continue their education through the COVID-19

crisis,” said Governor DeSantis. “Florida is truly raising the bar for distance learning.”

“I am grateful our staff at the Department were able to quickly identify funds and work with Florida's educational consortiums, whose membership is made up of smaller rural districts that often need help consolidating resources, and determine the gaps in device accessibility for students, many of whom are low income and in need of this critical support,” said **State Board Chair Andy Tuck**.

When the COVID-19 crisis indicated the need for distance learning, the Department proactively began calling laptop suppliers throughout Florida and reaching out to Florida's rural county school district consortia to identify both available supply and demand.

“I am grateful for the work that all 67 county school districts did to implement their distance learning plans by March 30, and I'm equally grateful to support these students in districts that lacked the resources to fully equip their students and teachers for success,” said **Commissioner Corcoran**. “Nearly all of these students are low-income students, and Florida making the extra effort to fight for these students is another example of how Florida never relents in the fight to close achievement gaps.”

What to do at a Four-Way Stop Sign / Inoperable Traffic Light

A four-way stop is any intersection with a stop sign in each direction, a flashing red light in each direction, or an inoperable traffic light. Traffic lights that are not working should be treated as a four-way stop sign. Four-way stops are usually, but not always, labeled as such, having a rectangular sign below the octagonal shape which reads something to the effect of, "4-Way Stop," "Four-Way Stop," or "All-Way Stop."

- Each driver arriving at a four-way stop must first come to a complete stop, then one driver proceeds at a time.
- If turning, as you approach a four-way stop, use your turn signal about one hundred feet prior to reaching the stop sign. The four-way stop is one of the most crucial places for using your turn signal compared to almost any other driving situation.
- Four-way stops always operate in a clockwise direction. So, the car furthest to the right always has the right of way, and then cars take their turns in a clockwise direction.
- If multiple cars approach a four-way stop at about the same time, the driver

who comes to a complete stop first proceeds first.

- If two or more cars arrive at a four-way stop simultaneously, the driver furthest to the right always proceeds first, and each next driver in the clockwise direction follows.
- If four cars arrive at a four-way stop simultaneously, drivers going straight should proceed first. If all four are turning right, they may all proceed simultaneously. These aside, there is no distinguishable way to see who should go first, so the intersection is at a standstill until one driver gets up the nerve and begins to inch forward, alerting the other drivers of his or her intentions, and proceeds through the intersection (thus starting the clockwise rotation from that driver).
- If two cars opposite each other are proceeding straight, both turning right, or one proceeding straight with the other turning right, they may go at the same time. The turn then goes to the adjacent cars at the stop, who may follow the same rule if applicable.

Follow these tips to avoid adding further miscommunication to the situation.

- You must always stop at a four-way stop.
- **Pedestrians always have the right of way.** Please do not run anyone over simply because you think it's your turn to go; it may very well be your turn to

go, but if a pedestrian is in a crosswalk, do not proceed. Let that person clear the intersection before proceeding.

- Some drivers will ignore all the rules of the four-way stop and mistakenly assume that they have the right of way. Even if it is your legal turn to proceed forward, always do so with caution. Remember, some distracted drivers will be using a cell phone or texting, so be cautious and observant.

- **Please remember, if any emergency vehicle is approaching from any direction, pull over or leave room for the vehicle to pass safely. Emergency vehicles should always be given the right of way.**

The Lady Lake Police Department reminds you to be careful out on the roadways. We are approaching both Florida's hurricane and rainy seasons. These are times where you will encounter traffic lights out on U.S. Hwy 441. This is where you must be observant and courteous to avoid a traffic crash.

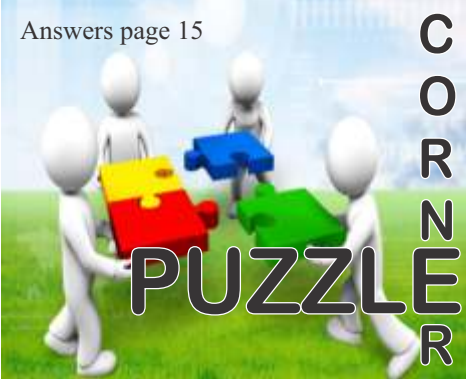

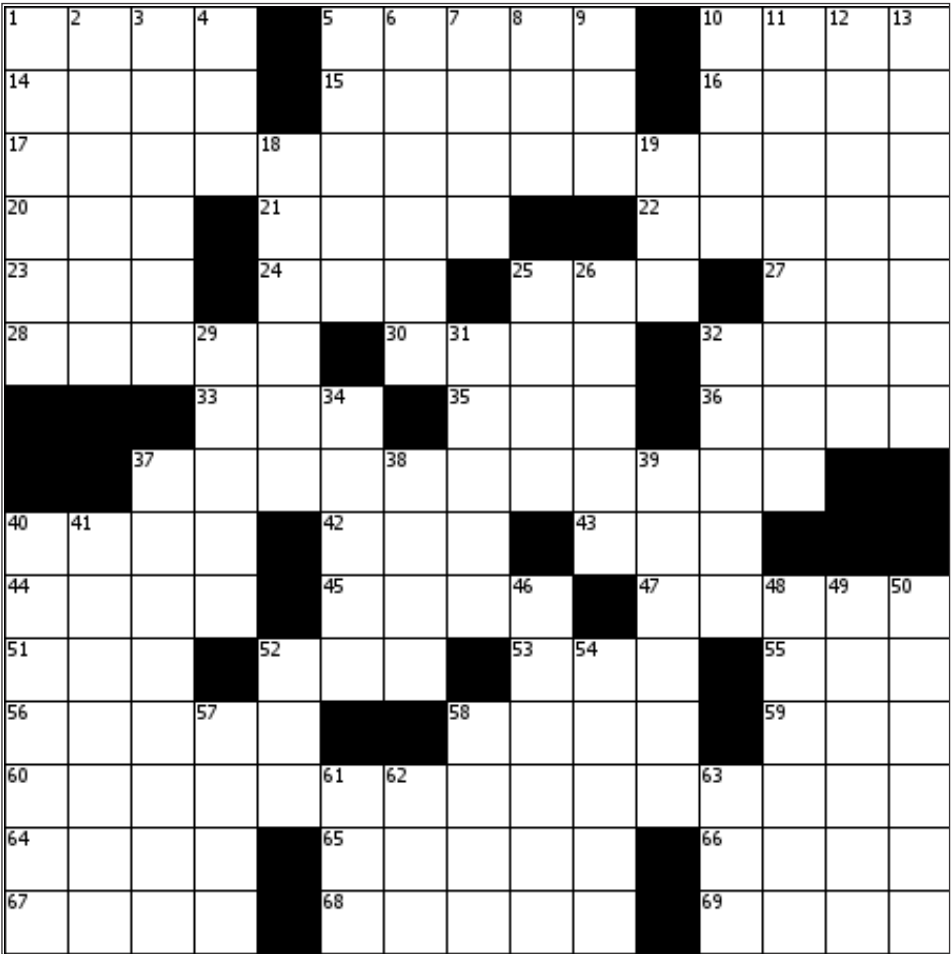

Coronavirus Image You've Seen a Million Times

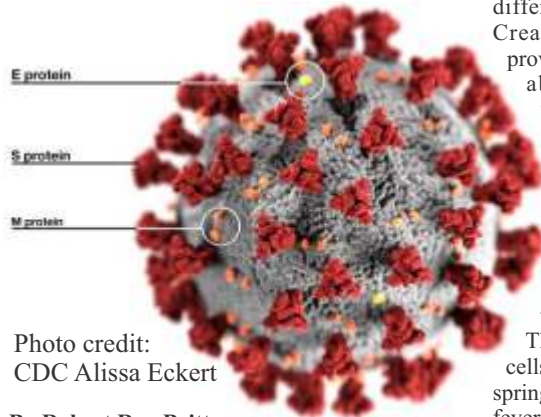

What the Coronavirus Image You've Seen a Million Times Really Shows

A colorful 3D rendering of a spiky fuzzball has spread around the world at least as fast as the coronavirus. The image, used by news media around the world, was created by Alissa Eckert, a medical illustrator at the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), along with her colleague Dan Higgins.

It is not a photograph, but rather an illustrated visualization of the microscopic coronavirus.

"The image was originally designed with the public in mind," Eckert tells *Elemental*. "However, it also serves to help researchers

differentiate and visualize their information. Creating visual representations of diseases provides a way to take something complex and abstract and make it tangible through visualization."

Viruses like SARS-CoV-2, the coronavirus that causes Covid-19 disease, are not technically living things, and they can't reproduce on their own. They invade cells in the bodies of animals, including humans, and take over — making people sick. The hijacked host cells then reproduce the virus. We may feel sick for two reasons: The virus can disrupt the normal function of our cells or destroy them; and our immune system springs into action, causing symptoms such as a fever, intended to kill the virus with heat.

The 3D rendering of the novel coronavirus uses vibrant colors that are not what would appear if you could see the virus with your own eyes, but here's what the image reveals:

The gray surface is a spherical envelope that surrounds the nucleus of the virus, containing genetic material.

Orange bits are a "membrane proteins," or M proteins, the most abundant structural protein in the virus and one that gives it form, says Eckert. These and other proteins vary from one type of virus to another, and can be used to help understand or identify one virus from another.

Yellow bits are envelope proteins (E proteins), the smallest of the structural proteins. They "play an important role either in regulating virus replication — such as virus entry — assembly and release," according to other research.

Red spikes: These clumps of proteins (called S proteins) are "what the virus uses to gain entry into and attach to the cell," says Eckert. They also create the effect of a halo, or corona, around the virus.

The red spikes latch onto human cells and cause

the membrane of the virus to fuse with the membrane of the human cell. The genes from the coronavirus can then enter the host cell and be copied.

The red spikes of the new coronavirus are "10 to 20 times more likely to bind" to human cells than the spike from the 2002 SARS coronavirus, researchers have found. "This may enable SARS-CoV-2 to spread more easily from person to person than the earlier virus, they conclude.

"Working with the virus as a three-dimensional structure allows you the freedom to interact with the structure and manipulate and design it as needed to convey the message," Eckert says. "One goal is that through this visualization we can help inform and educate the public about the disease, and thus hopefully help improve public health by limiting and halting the spread of disease."

Scientists are using the 3D rendering and many other different images and troves of genetic data to study the virus.

Earlier this year, scientists in China publicly released the genome sequence of the new coronavirus. Scientists at the National Institutes of Health and elsewhere are using that information, along with electron-microscope imagery and other data to develop a potential vaccine, which officials say is likely months away.

"We hope these findings will aid in the design of candidate vaccines and the development of treatments for Covid-19," says Dr. Barney Graham, deputy director of the Vaccine Research Center at the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases.

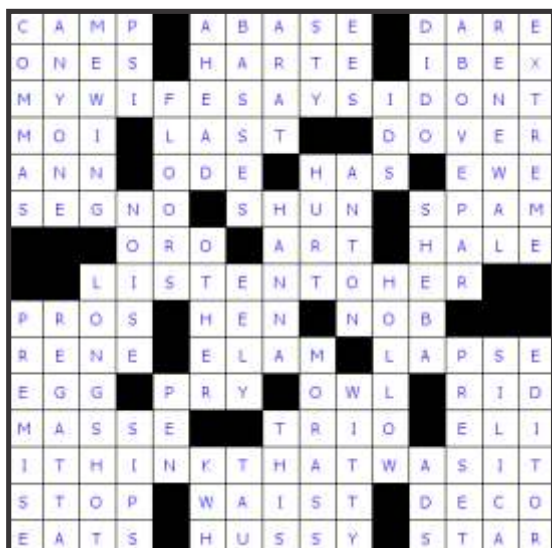
