Governor DeSantis to Biden Administration Do Your Job, Enforce the Law, Stop Incentivizing Illegal Immigration

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. – Instead of changing course to stop the crisis of mass illegal immigration occurring at the southwest border, the Biden Administration has taken yet another action to further weaken immigration enforcement, which will exacerbate the Biden Border Crisis. In a policy memo issued this week by Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Secretary Alejandro Mayorkas, the Biden Administration directed immigration authorities to stop deploying worksite operations that enforce illegal immigrant employment laws, effectively greenlighting American employers to hire illegal aliens.

“This latest action by DHS should come as no surprise given that mass illegal immigration is this administration’s policy, but yet again, Florida will fill the chasm left by the Biden Administration’s refusal to enforce the law,” said **Governor Ron DeSantis**. “State and federal law explicitly prohibit the employment of illegal aliens. In Florida, we will enforce the law, and we will protect the jobs and wages of Florida’s workers.”

This week’s memo is just the latest directive from the Biden Administration to hamstring immigration authorities and facilitate mass illegal immigration at the southwest border. States bear the brunt of this administration’s open borders agenda. That is why Governor DeSantis has taken many actions to address the Biden Border

Crisis. On August 26, the Governor sent a letter to DHS Secretary Mayorkas urging the Biden Administration to provide more transparency concerning the resettlement of illegal aliens in Florida and to consult in advance with state leadership before illegal aliens are resettled in the state. Forty-eight days later, the letter is still unanswered.

On September 28, Governor DeSantis issued Executive order 21-223, which prohibits all Florida agencies under the purview of the Governor from facilitating illegal immigration into Florida, unless otherwise required by federal or state law, and requires the collection of information from state officials on the scope and costs of illegal immigration in Florida.

The Governor appointed former U.S. Attorney Larry Keefe as the state’s first Public Safety Czar to ensure the actions directed in the executive order are carried out.

The State of Florida has filed suit against the Biden Administration challenging its “catch and release” policy.

Employing an unauthorized alien is a state and federal offence, and Florida will fill the enforcement gap left by the Biden Administration. If an individual wishes to report non-compliance, they can visit <http://www.floridajobs.org/verify-florida> or send an email to

these sites, the 7-day average of new adult hospital admissions has fallen 80%.

“Florida has administered over 130,000 monoclonal antibody treatments, saving thousands of people from being admitted to the hospital. There is no doubt that many lives have been saved as a result of making these treatments widely available,” said **Governor Ron DeSantis**. “Recently, the Biden administration decided to severely cut the amount of Regeneron monoclonal antibodies being sent to Florida and other disfavored states. That was concerning because there was a significant demand for the treatments and we wanted to make sure that if folks needed it, they were able to get it. I looked to see what other options were available for Florida. There was another very effective monoclonal antibody treatment called Sotrovimab made by GlaxoSmithKline that had recently received emergency use authorization. We went directly to GlaxoSmithKline, got Sotrovimab for Florida, and deployed it. It served as a bridge to get over the reductions, and fortunately, as a result of the success of early treatment, our infections are now so low that we have gone from thousands to hundreds of treatments per day. Florida is one of the only states in the country that currently has hospital admissions for

COVID below pre-Delta levels and is also one of the five lowest states for daily infections.”

“The State of Florida has continued to ensure monoclonal antibody treatments are widely available in Florida for all who need them,” said **Dr. Joseph Ladapo**, Surgeon General of Florida. “Not only has it alleviated demand on the hospital system, but it has saved countless lives by administering more than 130,000 treatments since August 12. Responding to COVID-19 does not have one solution, but requires innovative strategies just like this, and the Department of Health continues to support these missions under the Governor’s leadership.”

Total COVID hospital census in our state has had 51 consecutive days of decline. The 7-day average in Florida for COVID-like illness emergency room visits is lower than 33 other states. To help reinforce Florida’s supply of monoclonal antibody treatment, the [Governor secured thousands of doses of Sotrovimab](#) directly from GlaxoSmithKline last month.

The Governor was joined at today’s event by Floridians who shared their stories about receiving monoclonal antibody treatment.

Apparently, the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Lady Lake voted against a developer.

That would be a first if that developer was 'The Villages'.

But it's not!

The request was for 82 new residences on an 18 acre site located next to the 'Lake Sumter Apartment Homes' on the corner of CR 466 and Cherry Lake Road, called 'Sumter Villas'.

This despite the fact that Lady Lake does supply water to the huge 'Lake Sumter Apartments' next door, and in Sumter County.

The Mayor of Lady Lake, Ruth Kussard was quoted *"An important thing to remember is (that) this is in Sumter County. We would have absolutely no jurisdiction over this project. Why would we give our water to another county? We need to look out for the residents of Lady Lake."*

Commissioner Tony Holden said *"The town (of Lady Lake) should not be propping up development in Sumter County. We are not in the business of developing in Sumter County. We already have too much invested over there. Let's stick to the Town of Lady Lake and Lake County,"*

Commissioner Dan Vincent asked why 'The Villages' isn't extending water for the planned development.

"Why aren't you going to The Villages?" he asked.

An obvious answer is *"Why would 'The Villages' enable competition?"*

Back in the 90's, the State of Florida

approved the use of about 63 million gallons a year for The Villages.

Now 'The Villages' sucks up about 12.4 BILLION gallons from the aquifer every year.

As if that's not enough, there's another 850 million gallons annually for their extensions into Wildwood/Coleman in Sumter County.

Twenty years ago, the St. Johns River Water Management District (SWMD) admitted that the aquifer had dropped as much as 10 feet in 'The Villages' and, as predicted, that has continued.

Not to be deterred, they just extended the permit to the lower aquifer.

Is that a problem?

Well, the springs are down every year, wetlands are drying up and sink-holes are often reported within 'The Villages'.

Even now we have salt water intrusion in coastal areas.

Sounds like a problem to me!

Is there a solution?

Not really!

In our system, wealth is created by development- residential, commercial, government, recreation. streets and services.

Almost every day we see politicians and business leaders bragging on creating another 5,000 jobs.

At the same time, we have thousands of unfilled jobs, so we are urgently in need of more people.

That means, more homes, more schools, more cars, more highways, more shops, stores and services.



married for more than 60 years and have seven children. Wally is a World War II and Korean War naval aviator veteran. Doris spoke about the couple's recovery, saying: "As the governor said, [monoclonal antibody treatment] saves lives. It saved my husband's life. the body, the central nervous system misfires like a faulty circuit board—one that cannot be fixed without replacing the blown fuses. This major physiological malfunction tends to trigger the onset of some of the hardest-to-treat neurodegenerative diseases, including Alzheimer's disease and multiple sclerosis (MS).

These are terrible afflictions that affect millions of North Americans. They also cost the healthcare system billions of dollars a year, mostly spent on managing physical and mentally debilitating symptoms that inexorably get worse.

What's more, current treatments can only "modify" (slow down or mitigate) the destructive effects on the human body caused by the mass death of neurons in the brain or spine.

The Search For A Solution

With that all said, many people may be relieved to learn of a small Canadian-headquartered biotech start-up that offers new hope to tens of millions of sufferers of neurodegenerative diseases. With Phase 1 clinical trials already underway, NervGen Pharma believes it's on-track to become a big breakthrough thanks to its blockbuster drug candidate—NVG-291.

NVG-291 is a peptide (a small protein) that works by targeting the protein tyrosine

phosphatase sigma (PTP?) receptor that blocks nerve repair following injury, whether from trauma or conditions such as MS or Alzheimer's disease. NervGen targets nerve cell repair, while promoting plasticity to create new neural pathways.

NVG-291 is the brainchild of Dr. Jerry Silver, a renowned spinal cord injury and regenerative medicine researcher whose pioneering work addresses a diversity of conditions defined by a damaged central nervous system. These include degenerative diseases, spinal cord damage, stroke and traumatic brain injury.

Researchers are currently conducting trials in healthy volunteers. This will transition to studies for several of these medical ailments. In particular, the company has stepped up its interest in NVG-291's ability to tackle Alzheimer's disease.

The company works with Dr. Ksenia Kastanenko of Massachusetts General Hospital—which has a long history of supporting cutting-edge research and innovation in medical research—to study NVG-291 in animal models of Alzheimer's disease.

It's also preparing to enter a Phase 1b clinical trial for Alzheimer's patients in 2022 following ongoing Phase 1 safety trials for the drug candidate.

An Expert's Opinion

According to NervGen's CEO, Paul Brennan, "The multiple preclinical studies that we are conducting, as well as our planned Phase 1b study, are important milestones for our Alzheimer's program, which, if successful, will provide a meaningful benefit to patients and significant potential for NervGen."

"What differentiates NVG-291 from other drugs in development is that it leverages multiple mechanisms for repairing nerve damage, while most others focus on a single approach. Alzheimer's disease is a complex condition and likely

caused by multiple factors. We believe that a systems approach to treating the disease is an important distinction."

first," Bramlett said. "It felt too new."

Then her son attended church camp, and, unknowingly, brought the virus home. Bramlett woke up one morning with a throbbing headache, 103-degree fever and fatigue. She also discovered she had lost her sense of smell and taste, telltale symptoms of the coronavirus. Eleven days later, she couldn't get out of bed. Her head was hurting so badly that her husband took her to the hospital where they checked her for a brain bleed.

"I was terrified because I had never had head pain like this before," said Bramlett. She was diagnosed with inflammation of her brain vessels and myocarditis, a heart condition that made her heart feel like she was constantly running on a treadmill. Her body swelled as her kidney functions failed. Her recovery ultimately took 72 days.

"It was really, really scary and I don't wish that on anybody," Bramlett says of the experience.

While Bramlett was ill, she asked her doctor if she could get vaccinated, but her medical team advised that she had to wait

until she was feeling better. The moment she was cleared, Bramlett went right to the drug store for her vaccine.

"The hardest part was that people were dying all around me the entire time I was sick—healthy people, young people," Bramlett reflects. "I just felt so stupid. Here's this vaccine available and I just assumed that it wouldn't happen to me."

In fact, COVID-19 remains a serious threat across the U.S. as we head into the pandemic's second winter. The Delta variant, which now makes up virtually all cases in the country, spreads more easily than the common cold and has led to a dramatic increase in hospitalizations nationwide. This rise in serious cases and deaths was most pronounced in the Southern U.S., where vaccination rates are lower.

What The CDC Says

According to the Centers For Disease Control and Prevention, people who have not yet been vaccinated are 29 times more likely to be hospitalized and 11 times more likely to die from COVID-19 complications, compared to those who have already received their vaccine.

Other CDC data reveals people ages 18 to 49 are the largest demographic hospitalized for COVID-19 as of September 25. Studies also show that even for individuals who have a mild case of COVID-19 and avoid hospitalization, they remain at risk of post-COVID symptoms, often called long COVID, that may last for weeks, months or

State Surgeon General Dr. Joseph A. Ladapo Designated as Chair of the Florida Children & Youth Cabinet

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. – Today, Governor

Ron DeSantis announced the resignation of First Lady Casey DeSantis as Chair of the Florida Children and Youth Cabinet and the designation of State Surgeon General Dr. Joseph A. Ladapo as the new Chair.

“I’m proud of the First Lady’s leadership as Chair of the Florida Children and Youth Cabinet,” said **Governor Ron DeSantis**. “Her commitment to children is unmatched, and she has continued to foster collaboration across state and local partners to benefit families in our state. As a mother, she understands that Florida’s youth need our support, love and care and we are all better for her leadership over the past three years.”

Originally appointed in 2019, First Lady DeSantis led the Cabinet with distinction, recognizing the bandwidth and horsepower of the talented group of individuals serving on the Cabinet. The First Lady continuously challenged members to take a holistic approach to addressing the needs of children in our state. Under her leadership, the Cabinet tackled critical issues and aided

in the state’s pandemic response, notably including:

• In 2019, First Lady DeSantis directed the Cabinet to focus on prevention of youth suicide by establishing two workgroups: one to find and review current-situation data statistics, and the second to research the best and most-promising prevention efforts, particularly regarding mentorship. The working groups presented reports in 2020 – naming mentorship as the number one recommendation for focus moving forward.

• In 2020, First Lady DeSantis announced that the Florida Department of Education (FDOE) and the Florida Department of Children and Families (DCF) partnered to provide nearly 1,000 devices to Florida children in foster care in need of a mobile technology device, such as a laptop, to help address the unique challenges to educational stability that these students confront.

• In 2020, First Lady DeSantis designated Agency for Health Care Administration Secretary Simone Marsteller to lead a workgroup to expand the effort to address stigma associated with mental health – particularly in minority communities across the state and beyond. Secretary Marsteller presented a report in 2021 outlining short-term and long-term steps that the state can take to address the social stigma within minority communities

– naming peer support as the number one recommendation for focus moving forward.

• In 2021, First Lady DeSantis charged the Cabinet with reviewing the FDOE Resiliency Curriculum and Toolkit and asked that members present on ways to incorporate the key tenets – problem solving skills, critical thinking skills and the value of mentorship, empathy, respect and responsibility – into work on behalf of Florida’s children and youth moving forward.

On July 11, 2007, legislation was signed that created the Children and Youth Cabinet. The Cabinet is charged with promoting and implementing collaboration, creativity, increased efficiency, information sharing and improved service delivery between and within state agencies and organizations. As directed by statute, in 2007 the Cabinet developed a shared vision and a Strategic Plan to guide the Cabinet in designing and implementing measurable outcomes and actions that promote collaboration and information sharing.

Florida Was Right: The Federal Government Admits Governor DeSantis’ Decision to Put Seniors First Was the Correct Approach to Vaccine Distribution

The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services acknowledges in a new report that early vaccination of seniors saved lives

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. – Today, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services released a report which validates Governor

DeSantis’ *Seniors First* vaccination policy, declaring that “efforts to prioritize and vaccinate” those 65 and older “helped prevent hundreds of thousands of new COVID-19 infections and tens of thousands of deaths among seniors” and “directly correlate[s] to saving lives.”

“As the COVID vaccines first became available, I made it clear that in Florida we were going to put *Seniors First* to make sure the most vulnerable received the protection they needed,” said **Governor Ron DeSantis**. “Following Florida’s lead, earlier this year [the federal government reversed course](#) from prioritizing younger populations for vaccinations to recommending that states prioritize seniors age 65 and older. When I decided to put *Seniors First*, the data clearly showed that prioritizing vaccines for seniors would save the most lives. It was the right thing to do, and I am glad to see the federal government has continued to acknowledge this reality.”

The HHS study analyzed the estimated reductions in COVID infection, hospitalization, and death for seniors in the 20 most populous states through the end of May. At that time, only four of those states had higher senior vaccination rates than Florida and the study estimates that in Florida *Seniors First* reduced senior infections by 17,000, hospitalizations by 6,700, and deaths by 2,400.

Florida currently has the highest vaccination rate in the southeast and one of the highest senior vaccination rates in the country. Over 4.5 million seniors have chosen to get vaccinated in Florida.





While a bone marrow or blood stem cell transplant can serve as a cure for leukemia and other blood cancers, only 30 percent of patients have a matching donor in their families. The remaining 70 percent must hope that a compatible stranger can be found through the global registry.

Seeking Solutions

For the past 30 years, one organization has been singularly passionate about engaging the public to get everyone involved in curing blood cancer. Gift of Life Marrow Registry, a nonprofit based in Boca Raton, Florida, works globally to find matching bone marrow and blood stem cell donors for patients battling nearly 100 diseases, including blood cancer, immune disorders and sickle cell.

One Man's Story

The best chance of finding a matching donor is with people who share the same ethnicity and race—and Gift of Life was founded due to a lack of Jewish donors in the national registry when Jay Feinberg was 22 years old and unable find a match to cure his leukemia.

Determined to save his life, Feinberg's family and friends set on a 4-year grassroots donor recruitment campaign, resulting in the enrollment of more than 60,000 new donors in the worldwide bone marrow registry. Feinberg eventually found his lifesaving match, and his diagnosis started the butterfly effect that became Gift of Life.

Feinberg has never taken for granted the

gift that his bone marrow donor gave to him, and he has turned a moment of personal crisis into a lifetime of achievement for the greater good and now, you can be part of it.

"Every day I live is a day I am blessed to pay it forward," said Feinberg. "Everyone has the power to spread light by joining the registry and giving the most precious gifts of all—hope and health."

Gift of Life

Under Feinberg's leadership as the Founder and CEO, Gift of Life has grown into a multi-faceted organization that operates a global marrow and blood stem cell donor registry, donor collection center, cellular therapy laboratory and a soon-to-launch biotech entity. To date, the organization has a membership of nearly 400,000 individuals who have volunteered to save a life, and it has also facilitated more than 4,000 transplants.

What That Means To The Jews

Through many years of recruiting and partnerships with Jewish communities and organizations, Gift of Life has radically increased the rates of survival for patients of Jewish descent (from 5 to approximately 80 percent), and is working to do the same for other ethnicities and races.

What You Can Do

While it's great to help the organization at anytime, this Hanukkah can be a particularly good time. You can join Gift of Life's Swab Sameach campaign that is dedicated to uniting the Jewish community with the common goal of saving lives. Homemade Butterfingers



Homemade Butterfingers are the most addictive candy bars, maybe ever. These bite-sized chocolate bars are great for a Halloween bash, but they are also great for your everyday chocolate cravings!

Ingredients

- 3 cups candy corn
- 1 1/2 cups creamy peanut butter
- 2 cups good quality chocolate – milk, dark, or even white!

Instructions

1. Line a 9×9 inch baking dish with parchment paper (be sure to cover up the sides of the dish too), and set aside.

4. Melt the chocolate and then dip each piece of candy completely into the chocolate. Remove and place on a piece of waxed paper until the chocolate is set, about 20 minutes.
5. Serve or store in an air-tight container.

CONSUMER ALERT: Beware of Vaccine Status License Scam

TALLAHASSEE, Fla.—Attorney General Ashley Moody today issued a Consumer Alert

warning Floridians of a new COVID-19 vaccination text scam. There have been reports of fraudulent text messages being sent to Floridians asking for driver license details in order to remake licenses that show vaccination status. The text messages provide a link that sends targets to a spoofed Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles website with input boxes requesting Social Security and driver license information—including a place to upload a photocopy of a driver license.

Attorney General Ashley Moody said, “COVID-19 cases have decreased drastically across the state, but that hasn't stopped scammers from finding new angles to exploit the pandemic. Please be on the lookout for phony messages and remember that the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles will never reach out via text and ask for personal information. Florida is not updating driver licenses to include proof of vaccination—any solicitation making this claim is a scam that should be reported immediately.”

Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles Executive Director Terry L. Rhodes said, "The best defense against scams like this is to know how FLHSMV interacts with our customers. We do not text Floridians regarding the status of their driver license or request personal or medical information via text message. If you receive a text asking for this information, it is a scam. With only the information on your driver license, scammers can create many fraudulent financial accounts. All under your name, all without your knowledge. Do not respond to these texts and do not click on the links contained in the text message.”

The link in the message will bring you to a spoofed Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles website.

Attorney General Moody is asking Floridians to follow the tips below to avoid these types of imposter scams:

- Know that the FLHSMV is not requiring driver license updates listing proof of vaccination;
- Do not automatically trust a number listed on a caller ID or in an unsolicited text message;
- Do not post photos of vaccination cards or driver licenses online, as they can be used to commit identity fraud; and
- Avoid clicking on links in a suspicious email or in a text message received from an

unknown sender.

Report suspicious solicitations or COVID-19 vaccine-related advertisements to the Florida Attorney General's Office by calling 1(866) 9NO-SCAM, or visiting MyFloridaLegal.com.

Attorney General Moody Warns Floridians About Lethal Counterfeit Pills Flooding the Black Market

TALLAHASSEE, Fla.—Attorney General Ashley Moody is warning Floridians about the recent explosion in deadly counterfeit pills confiscated nationwide. The United States Drug Enforcement Administration recently seized 1.8 million fentanyl-laced pills in a two-month nationwide sting that launched on Aug. 3. Since the start of 2021, officials have seized more than 9.5 million counterfeit pills—an increase of nearly 430% since 2019. Fentanyl is a synthetic opioid 50 times more potent than heroin and is an accelerating force behind the increase in drug overdose deaths.

Attorney General Ashley Moody said,

“We are seeing a nationwide increase in the amount of fentanyl coming across our border. We are also seeing a dramatic spike in the number of overdose deaths attributed to fentanyl. As Florida's Attorney General and as a mother, I don't want anyone to abuse drugs, but please be especially warned that if you take a pill from anyone other than your doctor, you may be risking your life. Just one dose of fentanyl can kill, and with an increasing number of these counterfeit pills circulating throughout the country, the message is more important today than ever before.”

According to the DEA, opioids are responsible for nearly 75% of the more than 93,000 fatal drug overdoses in the U.S. in 2020. The flooding of new fentanyl-laced drugs could accelerate opioid deaths. According to the latest FDLE Medical Examiners Report, 21 people in Florida die from opioid-related overdoses every day. Last year, deaths attributed to fentanyl in Florida increased by more than 80%. Recent reports highlight the toll these deadly fentanyl pills are having on teens nationwide.

Just two milligrams of fentanyl can be lethal depending on a person's body size, tolerance and past usage. Following last month's sizeable seizure, DEA's lab results revealed that four out of every 10 fake pills contained a potentially lethal dose of fentanyl. According to the DEA, just a few years ago, about 10% of drugs tested contained fentanyl—that is now up to 40%


